Duties/Responsibilities:

- Perform on-site clinical counseling services to patients of Tabula Rasa Psychology, as scheduled, and in accordance with company policies.
- Regular and reliable attendance and timely arrival to work is required.
- Be properly licensed and abide by all laws, rules, regulations, and codes of ethics that are binding upon or applicable to the services performed for Tabula Rasa Psychology.
- Respond to patients' requests for service or calls within 24 hours whether such requests
 are made in person, by phone, voicemail, etc. or through the Tabula Rasa Psychology
 website. Respond to such requests by meeting, evaluating, and providing services to
 such patients.
- Communicate with a patient's treatment team (i.e., PCP, psychiatrist, school, etc.) as necessary.
- Timely complete written records for each patient including, but not limited to: intake
 notes, progress notes, treatment plans, termination notes, contract notes, and other
 forms or documents which may be needed or required from time-to-time by Tabula
 Rasa Psychology or third parties in conjunction with the treatment of the patient within
 a timely fashion (by Friday of each week). Keep patient files accurate and up to date.
- Provide informed consent to patients by notifying them of our processes to collect payments for services provided consistent with the policy and rate for such services as established by Tabula Rasa Psychology.
- Attend mandatory staff meetings and training as directed by Tabula Rasa Psychology.
- Attend supervision meetings as scheduled.
- Conduct and regulate counseling services in a professional manner so as to maintain and increase the good will and reputation of Tabula Rasa Psychology. Be respectful of and cooperative and collaborative with co-workers of Tabula Rasa Psychology, North Houston Birth Center, and Preggers Can Be Choosers.
- Passion for working with others (being collaborative) and helping our team members grow and learn.
- Other duties as may be assigned.

Qualifications and Skills:

- Align with Tabula Rasa Psychology mission, vision, and values.
- Speak both English and Spanish highly preferred.
- Must be punctual in reporting to work.
- Master's Degree or Doctoral Degree in counseling or social work; and

- Be organized and detail oriented.
- Be a team player.
- Be able to work independently on tasks assigned with confidence in asking for help when necessary.
- Have strong written and verbal communication skills and strong interpersonal skills.
- Prior experience in a private practice setting highly preferred.
- It is preferred to have at least one niche market for counseling services (i.e., children, teens, trauma, anxiety, grief, anger management, etc.), however we will focus on perinatal mental health and issues surrounding birthing persons adjusting to life after parenthood in this practice.
- Current approval as an in-network provider with insurance carriers (highly preferred).
